

C. Thorwald Arvidsson proposes (item no. 16, 17 and 18 of the proposed agenda):

16. That § 5 of the Articles of Association should read as follows: "There shall be not less than 545,000,000 shares and not more than 2,180,000,000 shares. Each share shall entitle the holder to one vote."
That the remainder of § 5 and § 6 in its entirety shall be deleted
That the numbering of the sections shall be amended accordingly
That all shares of both class A and class B shall be converted into shares without classification.
17. To instruct the Board to act to abolish the possibility of so-called voting differentiation in the Swedish Companies Act, primarily, through a petition to the government.
18. To instruct the Board to prepare a proposal for representation of the small and medium-sized shareholders both in the Board and in the Nomination Committee. The instruction shall include to act for an amendment to the Swedish regulation, primarily through a petition to the government.
