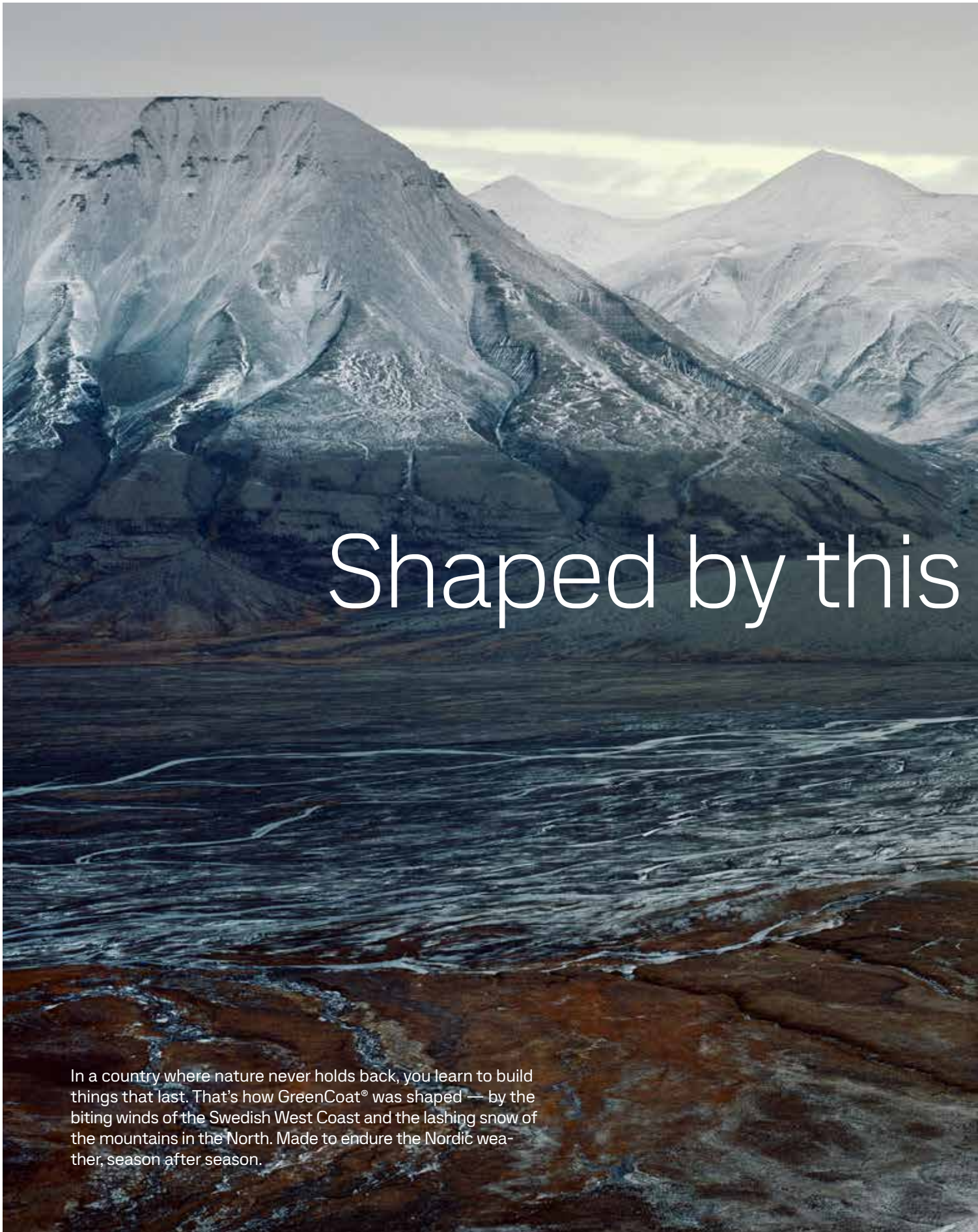

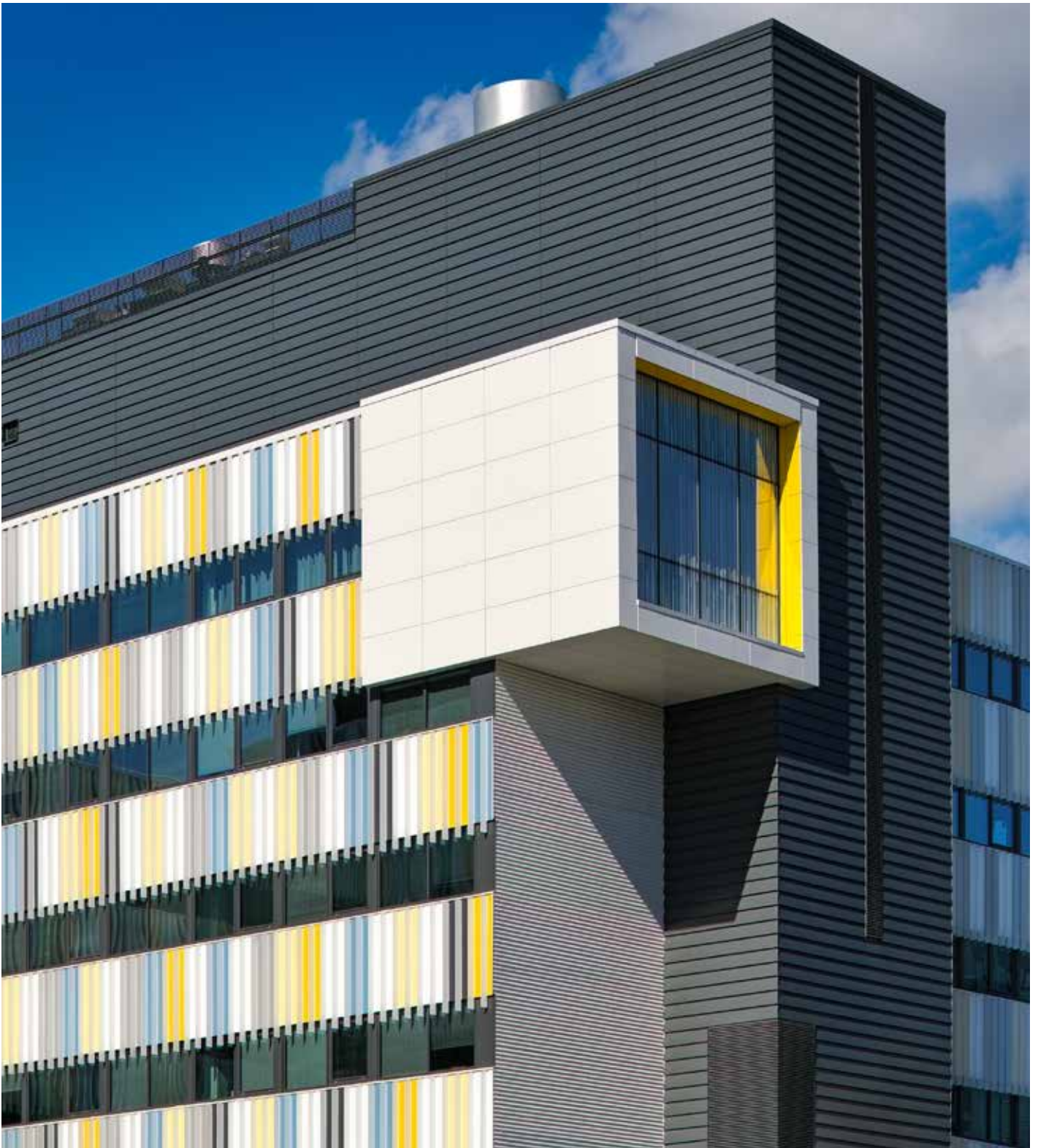

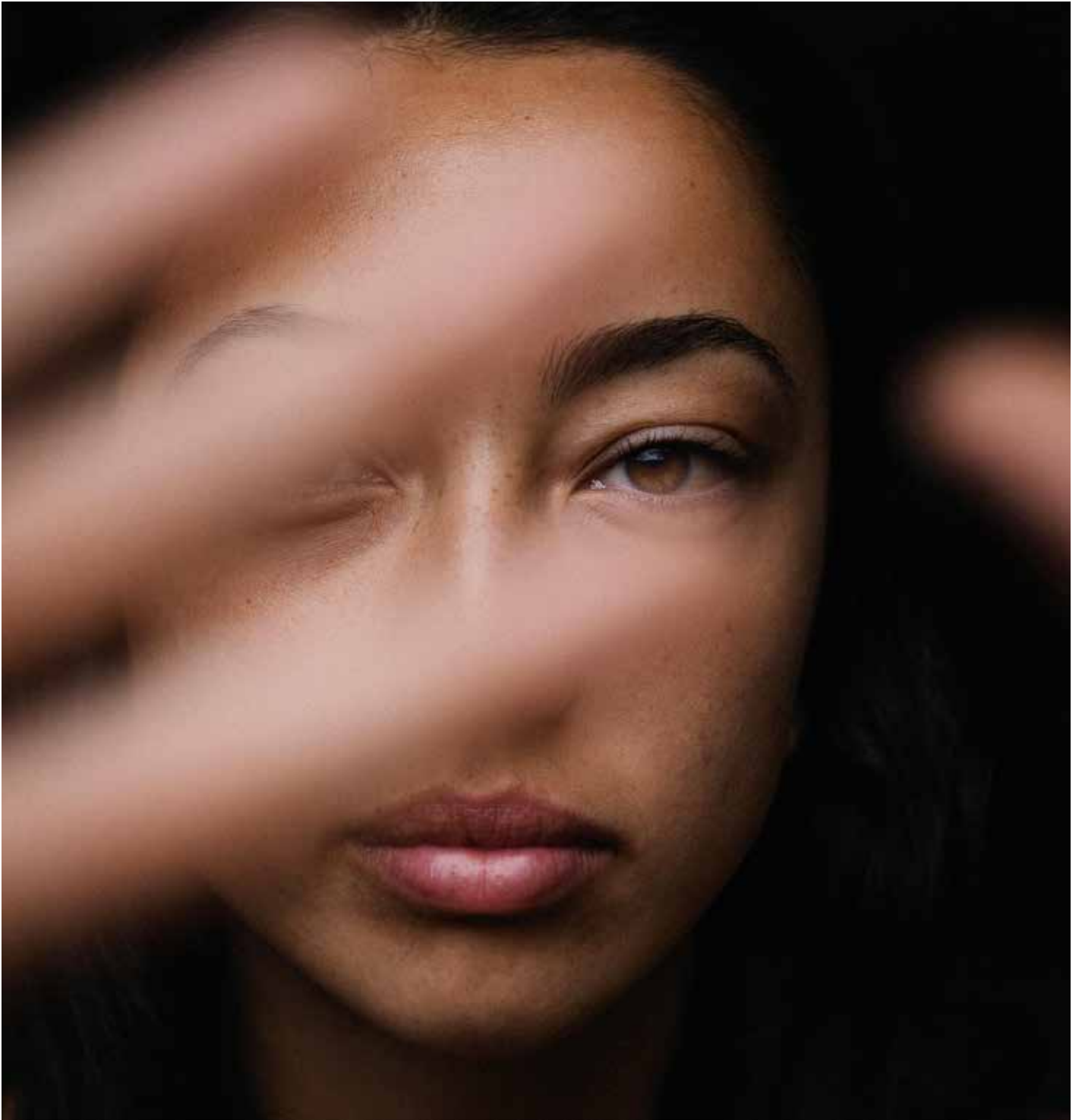




GreenCoat® Environmental Product Declaration (EPD)
